



# ENDERBY PARISH COUNCIL

## **BURIAL CHARGES & FEES & TERMS & CONDITIONS:** **ENDERBY NEW CEMETERY, LEICESTER LANE, ENDERBY**

Fees, payments and sums fixed by Enderby Parish Council in pursuance of its powers acting as Burial Authority for the Parish of Enderby in the County of Leicestershire, under Article 15 of the Local Authorities Cemeteries Order, 1977.

Burial, Interment, Memorial Fees & Charges & Other Fees listed in this document are based on the deceased's last address.

When Exclusive Rights of Burial are purchased in advance, the purchaser must provide proof of his or her name and address;

**Funeral Directors:** In the case of a funeral being arranged by a Funeral Director, proof of the deceased's last residing address is to be verified prior to the issue of Exclusive Rights of Burial by means of an Interment Notice from the respective Funeral Director or individual arranging the burial/interment.

Funeral Directors will be required to submit Burial Certificates prior to each burial/interment. These will then be verified against the Interment Notice submitted to establish the correct level of fees has been applied.

**Individuals:** In the case of advance purchases of Exclusive Rights of Burial by an individual(s), proof of name and address will be required to be given. All purchasers of Exclusive Rights of Burial will be issued a copy of the Council's existing and current Burial Charges & Fees & Terms & Conditions. This will be explained prior to the transaction being completed and a copy will be signed by the Purchaser in acknowledgement of the fees. This copy will be held on file.

Different rates are applied to Parishioners and Non-Parishioners;

A '*Parishioner*' is a person who immediately before his or her death was an inhabitant, or parishioner, of Enderby; or in the case of a still-born child, the parents (or one of them) are, at the time of interment, such inhabitants or parishioners.

A '*Non-Parishioner*' is a person who immediately before his or her death was *not* an inhabitant or parishioner, of Enderby. In the case of a still-born child, that child will be considered to be a 'Non-Parishioner' if neither of the parents was an inhabitant or Parishioner of Enderby at the time of interment.

Enderby Parish Council will review Burial Charges & Fees annually and they will be subject to change. The current document will be published on the Parish Council's web site.
